Any exhibitor entering a Novice Amateur class may enter the corresponding Amateur/Amateur Select class for free.

All Around Awards To Each Division: Same Horse/Same Rider Combination

Entry into halter classes NOT required for all-around, however halter points will count towards all-around in divisions offering halter classes. (In the event of a tie in Novice & Select classes - halter points will be used). Points earned in green classes are NOT included towards all-around. Contestants must compete in 3 or more classes in that division to be eligible for the all-around award.


